



# FACILITIES CHARGE EXEMPTION FOR SENIOR CITIZEN AND PERMANENTLY DISABLED RESIDENTS

The North Hudson Sewerage Authority (NHSA) charges a Facilities Charge to all units within its service area. Customers residing in the service area who are: 65 years of age or older or, regardless of age, permanently and totally disabled as set forth in N.J.S.A. 40:14A-8.2, may apply for an exemption from this charge. Only one exemption may be granted per customer account. A customer is defined as an individual who receives a bill for sewerage services directly from the Authority.
