Any new sewer connection with a designed project flow in excess of 400 gallons within the service area of the Authority requires the approval of the Authority Engineer. Any new sewer connection with a designed project flow in excess of 8,000 gallons within the service area of the Authority also requires the approval of the Authority Board and the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR REVIEW

-Two (2) copies of written application for construction of sewer facilities, including TWA-1, WQM-006 and WQM-003, if >8,000 g.p.d., and required attachments.

- Application fee = \$500.00
- Review Fee(\$) $= 0.1 \times (\text{g.p.d. of discharge})$; minimum deposit = \$500.00
Maximum Initial Deposit = \$5,000.00
- Review Fee Surcharge(\$) $= 0.04 \times (\text{g.p.d. of discharge})$

The application fee and review fee surcharge are non-refundable. The review fee is a deposit to reimburse the Authority for the cost of review and subsequent fees may be required by the Authority for review of the application.

Minimum information required:

- One copy of building floor plans indicating units and/or use of proposed space
- Two (2) copies of sewer connection plans and specifications
- Name of Owner and Applicant
- Name of Project, if different from Project Address
- Block and Lot numbers on the current Tax Assessment Map
- Date of preparation of map and revision dates
- Graphic scale and reference median
- Storm water detention system design

Sewer connection review shall be acted upon within 45 days of the date of submission of a complete application to the Authority, or within such further time as may be consented to by the applicant.

Upon approval, a connection or tapping fee of \$5,722.00 per service unit shall be paid to the Authority.

The number of service units is determined by the following formula:

$$\frac{\text{Average daily flow of sewage for the connector}}{\text{Avg. daily flow of sewage for avg. single fam. residence (300gpd)}}$$
