



Construction of upgrades and improvements under the North Hudson Sewerage Authority Project "Boulevard East Combined Sewer Improvements" covers Boulevard East immediately south of Highwood Terrace to Hamilton Ave, Hamilton Ave from King Ave to Boulevard East, Highwood Ave from Boulevard East to Eldorado Pl, and the west end of Hudson Place. The \$14,197,905.00 upgrades and improvement cost were financed by the New Jersey Water Bank (NJWB). The NJWB is a State Revolving Fund program jointly administered by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and the New Jersey Infrastructure Bank (NJIB) and uses a combination of funds provided by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, the DEP, and the NJIB to provide very low interest loans to borrowers for environmental infrastructure projects.

This project will provide flooding, storm water, and sanity benefits during rain events for residents and businesses in the vicinity of the project limits within Weehawken, NJ. Construction is expected to start on Boulevard East and last approximately one year.

State Revolving Fund programs around the nation provide states and communities the resources necessary to maintain and improve the infrastructure protecting our valuable water resources nationwide.
